The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a federally funded program that assists low income households with the cost of heating their homes during the winter months. The 2018 - 2019 Regular HEAP program begins November 13, 2018. Emergency HEAP will open on January 2, 2019. The tentative closing date for HEAP is Mid-March. The Saratoga County Office for the Aging will be accepting walk in applications for persons 60 years of age and older as well as those under 60 and
