Doris L. Noonan

Doris was born on April 3, 1921 in Mechanicville, NY. Doris graduated from Saratoga High School in 1939, and went on to graduate from Charles S. Wilson Memorial Hospital in 1942 as a Registered Nurse.

Doris entered into service on April 1, 1943. She served in the US Army Nurse Corps, serving in Corsica, Sardinia, Italy, Southern France and at WWII's end she was assigned to the 170th Evac Hospital in Manila, Philippines. Doris served as Charge Nurse for medical and surgical procedures as well as in research wards. As charge nurse she was responsible for personnel and general nursing procedures. She was also part of the emergency surgery duty at the front lines in Po Valley Campaign. Doris received the American Campaign Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal European African Middle Eastern Campaign Medal and the WWII Victory Medal for her services. She was honorably discharge on April 8, 1946 at the rank of 1st Lieutenant.

Doris worked for 20 years as a OBGYN/GYN nurse, teaching and mentored many nurses for years at the Mary McClellan School of Nursing in Cambridge as well as the former Leonard Hospital in Troy, until she retired in 1977. Doris was a faithful member of St. Peters' Roman Catholic Church in Stillwater, and served as a Eucharistic minister and belonged to the Rosary Society.

The Saratoga County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of all the citizens of the County, in grateful recognition of her service in the defense of our nation, dedicates this date, *October 18, 2016* in honor of the memory of *Doris L. Noonan* .
