Automatic defibrillators update – Mayor is looking into, waiting for a response to inquiry.

Questioned if open burning is part of the new Zoning Law with discussion of the process used by the Town and the County and will research their procedures further. Department inspection held Saturday, May 12, was very informative for new board members.

Donovan Restoration to review renovations and cosmetic work needed on building. John Murphy suggested Saratoga Restorations as they do specific Firehouse restoration.

Federal Fire Fighter Grants application has been completed and is ready for submission.

A drill with Arvin Hart and the Rescue Squad will be held on Wednesday, May 30 at the Stillwater School Campus.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS-Robert Gerasia

Supt. reviewed his monthly report. (Copy on file)

Two wells have been cleaned, 1 well to be set up, would like Board to visit water plant to review the entire process. Altitude valve package is being prepared. Aqua-Stor inspected the water tanks and will send a report. People are leaving unwanted items at the garage; a dumpster was delivered to collect the discarded items. A lengthy discussion was held with regard to drainage along the old canal at the south end of the Village. Spoke regarding need for emergency generators for the main pump station and the Hudson Ave pump station.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Trustee John Murphy – spoke to Joan Ronda and Mark Minick regarding joint Water Committee meeting, will have meeting soon to determine priorities. Will meet with

Jason Rich, Mayor Martin and a representative from Roy McDonalds Office to discuss possible grant opportunities. Water Meter Bids – will speak to Engineer when he returns from vacation. Attorney bid advised other information should be discussed in executive session.

Trustee Raymond Walker-ZBA will need a training session, county will come and train ZBA members, recommended using a numeric system for tracking projects. He encouraged Trustees to come to the training session.

Trustee Ken Baker - Fire Department inspection and drainage issues behind J. Rever's property.

Trustee John Basile – distributed a written report outlining what has transpired with regard to sewer during the past month. (Copy on file) Discussion was held regarding applications for new connections, possibly sending 82 homes in Castle Cliff to the County (not currently in the plans developed at the Town level), and adding Ferry Lane to the system. It was suggested we obtain costs for the smoke testing to see if we can afford to hire out. Discussion was held regarding a possible connection to the County sewer system, it was explained that the excessive I&I would need to be removed from out system regardless of how we proceed with regard to the wastewater treatment plant. Trustee Basile received an email from Q. Kestner of Kestner Engineering regarding the interim report from 2005 which needs to be updated for the change to SPDES Permit. Mr. Kestner estimated this could be done for \$5,680.00 or less.

The Clerk distributed a written report (Copy on file) She advised she would probably need a meeting the last of the month for end of year transfers.

ATTORNEY – James Peluso

Attorney Peluso informed the Board DEC has proposed a meeting for June 12, 2007 at 10am with regard to water issues.
